VICE SECRETARY REPORT

To all South Jersey ASC Members:

I am submitting a report this month to communicate events that occurred last month, which affects the current positions on the JAC and our *policy.

Last month, Pam resigned from her position as Secretary, which was effective immediately on Tuesday evening - January 19th. I attached the resignation letter from Pam along with her expense sheet in this report to review. In Pam's absence, I assumed the full responsibilities of the Secretary for the month of January and listed a recap of the events that took place since the resignation, which includes the following:

Tuesday, January 19th: Pam informed me of her immediate resignation from her position as the Area Secretary and also communicated that the minutes were not yet copied/mailed to the GSRs. The Area Chairperson and Policy Chairperson were notified. I asked permission for the Treasurer to release a check in my name for the month of January, per the allotted amount of \$200.00, in an effort to complete the responsibilities in the Secretary's absence. Per policy, this request was approved. (Monthly fund was never released to the Secretary in the month of January).

*Wednesday, January 20th: *Last day to mail out the minutes - per policy*

I met with Pam to obtain all secretarial information and supplies that she was holding. In addition, Pam did not release any funds to me that may have been paid to her by Area in past months. For accountability purposes, I asked Pam to sign a paper stating that funds were never exchanged between us and this is included within this document.

Thursday, January 21st: I met with the Treasurer, who wrote a check out in my name in the amount of \$200.00, to cover the cost of printing and mailing out the minutes.

Saturday, January 23rd: 60 copies of the January minutes were made (58-GSRs on file, 1-copy for Webmaster and 1-additional copy). The total cost of printing was \$199.73. The minutes were mailed to all GSRs whose information was listed in the address book received from the Secretary. Based on the priority of mailing out the minutes to the groups, the members of the JAC were not mailed out a hard copy of the minutes. All JAC members were emailed on January 25th communicating this information. The January minutes were mailed out on Saturday, January 23rd.

\$200 Secretary Fund Allotment: The monthly allotted amount for the Secretary of \$200.00 was not enough to cover the cost of the printing and mailing of the minutes. The postage to mail 58 packets totaled \$120.06. I applied the \$0.27 change from the copies made to the postage cost which left a remaining balance of \$119.79, of which was paid out of pocket and I will need to be reimbursed at today's Area Service Conference. I included both receipts for the body to review and feel that as a group, we need to discuss changing the current amount of \$200, as stated in policy and increasing the allotted fund amount to support the current cost of printing, mailing and supplies, and prevent future reimbursements from occurring. **Note – There was a motion sent back to groups in January to vote on re: increasing Secretary fund - we may not need to further discuss this topic, pending the groups decision.**

To address the topic of accountability of funds: Prior to January 21st, the allotted funds for the Secretary position were handled by the Secretary in position at that time. Regarding allotted funds in the month of January, I am submitting an updated expense form that includes the fund information communicated in this report.

Updated forms for Secretary: While assuming the responsibilities of the Secretary position, I have created / modified the following forms to aid with organization, accuracy and accountability:

- Created 2010 Secretary Expense Report - *to be included in monthly minutes for accountability of funds*
- Updated GSR Attendance Form- *to include monthly quorum information*
- Created a reimbursement form -*to be used as needed – motion may be needed to update policy to include the implementation of this new form*
- Updated GSR Information List - *to include option to print minutes from website - or -receive hard copy in mail – will obtain each GSR's preference prior to changing the current communication technique.*



Yesterday, February 13, 2010 I attended the H&I bi-monthly regional meeting in Lourdes hospital in Burlington County. Honestly in my opinion I was not that impressed with it. Basically there were H&I Chairs who went around the room and gave a report on their area's sub-committee. I was surprised to find out that the way we hold our h&i subcommittee was much different from all other areas. - Was told by another sub-committee member that he commended me for taking this position but our area sub-commitment structure was a mess and they were all here to help us fix it. (I was insulted, because ultimately we carry the message and that is our goal and purpose to all commitments are fulfilled each month even though we use a different method, I told them it works for our area. I felt as they they needed the principal of open-mindedness in their life that day.
- They also didn't like the way we distributed commitments each month. We go by clean time.
- At one point he questioned me and asked if we took in meeting alone, I felt as though he was trying to find as many flaws in our area as he could. That is my perception of how I felt.
- The regional chair said he is going to come to our area's sub-committee meeting to see how it ran and he also asked us if we had a policy and could send it to him.

However, I believe all of their hearts were in the right place, for the two hours I was there I felt extremely uncomfortable and felt as though I had to defend our area at all times and

I did a great job at it. I really did. To be honest with you I totally hated the experience but I will go back. I hope next time it is different. Also, I told the regional chair Adam, a third time that our area will host a regional meeting and he said ok. So in the future we will be doing that.
