Hello Everyone,

That string of nothing to report is over. I have a lot to report for you guys. I'm going to start with the CAR stuff and conclude with the convention. I will answer all questions as best as possible and defer to Jason on things I may not know or understand. We had region yesterday and I don't have a written report from our RD yet. So I'm summarizing his verbal report as well as the WSC Draft Summary of Decisions. You can find the DSoD at [NA.org](http://NA.org) under periodicals. You can also put [www.na.org/?ID=conference-index](http://www.na.org/?ID=conference-index) in your address bar and get to it there.

According to our RD and RDA as region we had a very good response to this years CAR. A lot of groups turned in ballots as a whole. As a region we tally group votes to carry our regions conscience. As a region:

Motion 1 Passed

Motion 2-6 Failed

All regional proposals passed

Again this was as a region

215 people were seated on the conference floor

115 seated regions

112 regions were represented

82 Alternate delegates

18 World Board Members

Out of the 82 alternate delegates

61 were from US

2 from Canada

19 outside US

7 Regions applied for seating the Dominican Republic was the only one seated.

The first thing they do at the WSC is to start the conference by passing Motion 7. What is Motion 7? We never saw anything in the CAR about Motion 7. Motion 7 "to adopt for WSC 2014 only, the following exceptions to the WSC Rules of Order:

Basically it let's motions and proposals to be amended and changed on the floor of the conference or after a straw pole to make it into formal old and new business sessions. This seems to be the direction that the WSC is moving. To see motion 7 in it's entirety it can be found on pg 2 of DSoD.

Motion 8

To approve 2012 WSC minutes: passed

Carried through a voice vote.

Motion 1

Passed with 2 revisions that were in CAT

Carried through a voice vote

Motion 2 failed through a voice vote

Motion 3 failed 64 yes 44 no 0 abstain 4 no vote



Motions 4,5,6 the agree in principle motions all passed 78- 28-0-1 all three were around these vote totals give or take a couple votes. All these motions were amended on the floor to read " to be included in the GTLS as an option along with our current service units. It was felt by our RD that if the motions were not amended on the floor they probably wouldn't have passed. Like I said early the WSC is changing the way the business at the conference gets done.

Motions 9-13 that were not in the CAR but were mentioned in the CAT were all to approve spending for the following projects plans. 9 was Fellowship Issue Discussion PP 10 was Service System Project Plan. 11 Traditions PP 12 Public Relations Project Plan. And 13 the 2014-16 NAWWS Budget. 9,10,12,13, were carried through a voice vote 11 was unanimous.

### Decisions Made through Proposals

In Motion 7 that I mentioned earlier they made it that proposals are as binding as motions. To deal with regional proposals the ones we saw as individual proposal rather than the summarized version we saw in the CAR. The final straw pole to do this was 49-46 To seat the region from the Dominican Republic.

After this pg 5-12 of DSoD dealt with how proposals, business, motions and ideas would be handled. I didn't have enough time to read and comprehend all of this and will report this at our next area. Along with the GSWSNA changes to straw poles. I think going over this will help us better understand how business at the WSC will be handled as a whole.

### **Motions 2 and 3 failed**

28 proposals were not supported in straw poles to formally make it in the new or old business sections of the WSC. All of the NJ regional proposals and all the proposals we saw in the CAR.

The NJ regional proposals were

- that all old business require 2/3 majority vote to pass WSC 2014

Opposition

- To remove the approach #5 state, region, province from SSP in the CAT

Strong Opposition

- Remove contribute button from NA

Strong Opposition

There was some other interesting stuff that failed like trying to remove the World Board vote in relation to the WSC process. Opposition

In summary Regions that think and vote like us are in the minority. However the opposition voice at the WSC was louder in 2014 then previous WSC but still minority.

There is a fund flow problem to the regional level. There are some factors contributing to this that were discussed at JAC meeting before region.

1. The economy.
2. The loss of last year's convention \$6500.
3. Members not carrying cash to Meetings to put in basket.
4. Cost of insurance to cover home groups in region.
5. Home group rents increasing so not as much money left to donate to region

Cost-cutting measures discussed that region

1. Limited PI exhibits posters etc.
2. Reducing places we send our RD and RDA to gather information for the region.
3. Looking at options of reducing help line phone cost.
4. Shopping regional insurance for a better price for the same coverage.

There is two ways that region gets money to operate from home group donations and the regional convention. So please come out and support the regional convention August 8, 9th, and 10th in Cherry Hill, New Jersey at the Crowne Plaza Hotel.

It was also suggested at region to see if areas would be interested in making a regional insurance donation, kind of like we do with a helpline donation. This is all for you guys to decide as groups our policy states that we give \$100 dollars every other month for the helpline donation.

The treasury report for region. We have \$18,894.97, we have a meeting list reserve of \$9,129.22. A formula is used to calculate what this is so we always have money to pay for the meeting list when they go to print. Which we just did and I brought those meetings list with me today. Our prudent reserve is \$5,500. This leaves us and operating budget of \$5800 when you add in donations from last month. Our insurance is due in September and the payment needs to be made in July our insurance cost is about \$5800 per year. As it stands this payment will exhaust our working capital. I reported back in January that region is broke and cost-cutting measures are being looked into and taken. Please discuss this at your home groups and any ideas on cutting cost and raising donations are welcomed.

I also put a history and archives flyer on the back table. Please take and pass around to your home groups or if your home group is old and has their history they would like to talk to you. I included the flyer in the minutes.

Region elections in July and September see the flyer for positions.  
Please come out and support.

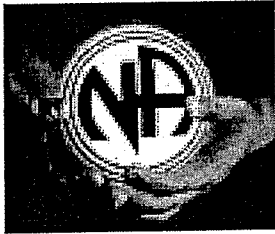
