The Bank Statement reconciled to the penny.

The Bank Statement for Activities was emailed to the Activities Treasurer and the Co-Chair yesterday.

Note to GSR's – please remember to completely fill out the Literature Supply form, especially the top and bottom sections which ask for Home Group name and location. It slows down our collection of money when we need to ask for that information when you get to the front of the line. We also ask that you get big bills, instead of lots of ones, and cash in change before coming to Area. Thank you for your cooperation.

The Secretary never cashed the April reimbursement check and hasn't been able to find it. I stopped payment on it and will reissue a replacement check today. The fee to stop payment is \$30.

ASC's Financial Position:

- August group donations were \$1,306.06
- August literature purchases were \$1,988.30
- Area expenses in August were \$2,752.97
- Literature expenses in August were \$1,711.65
- We were over cap in July and under cap in August – no donation will be made to Region this month (as per Policy, the lesser of 2 consecutive months). We do have a donation of \$726.41 from last month that will be given to Region next week.
- ASC checking account balance (as of this morning) is \$8,384.18 with 3 checks outstanding. These are the checks written to Region last month that will be turned in at next weeks meeting.

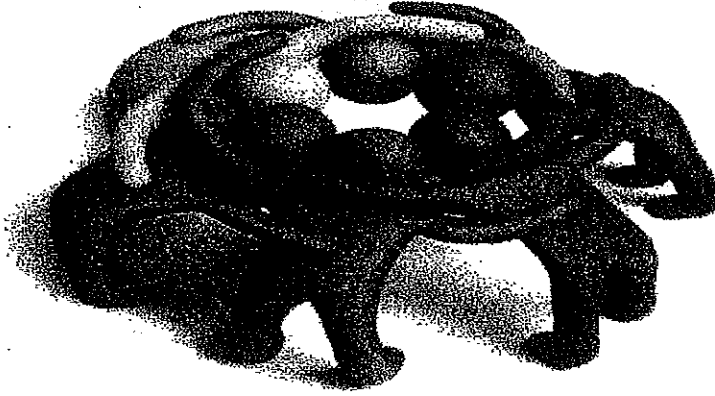
