# Directions

## From Route 95 Philadelphia (Benjamin Franklin Bridge):

Come over the Benjamin Franklin Bridge and stay **RIGHT**. Follow signs for Route 295/Route 42/Route 676 Atlantic City. You will need to get into the **LEFT** lane.

**\*\*\*Take Route 295 SOUTH (it will be a LEFT LANE turn). Follow 295 SOUTH to the first exit (Route 47 – Delsea Drive – Westville). Yield onto Delsea Drive (Route 47) and shortly, you will pass a lake with a bridge and gazebo on your left. Make your NEXT LEFT onto Duncan Avenue. At your first Stop sign St. John Lutheran’s Church is on your right. Make a RIGHT at the stop sign (you will enter through the double doors down on your right across from the parking lot). Make at LEFT at the first street and park down in the bank parking lot (as not to ruin the surprise).**

## From Route 95 Philadelphia (Walt Whitman Bridge):

Come over the Walt Whitman Bridge. Follow signs for Route 295/Route 42/Route 676 Atlantic City. Get into your **LEFT** lane and you will take Route 295 **SOUTH** (See \*\*\* above).

## From Route 295 in New Jersey (North of Philadelphia):

Follow Route 295 **SOUTH** towards Philadelphia (passing Marlton (Route 73) and Cherry Hill (Route 70)). At the Philadelphia Route 676 split, stay **RIGHT** towards Route 42/Route 295 Atlantic City. As you come around the curve stay **RIGHT** to continue onto Route 295 **SOUTH**. (See \*\*\* above).

## From Route 130 in New Jersey (Burlington/Camden):

Follow Route 130 **SOUTH** towards Collingswood. Follow around the Route 30 Circle (Collingswood Diner) and continue on Route 130. Follow Route 130 South past Route 168 (Blackhorse Pike/ Mt. Ephraim Avenue), and past the entrances to Route 676 and Route 42. Continue on Route 130 South until the Brooklawn Circle (Brooklawn Diner) and go  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the way around and make a right after the Hess station onto Route 47 – Delsea Drive. Stay right at the light (Y in the road) onto Broadway. Follow about  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile and make a left onto Willow Street (b/w First Colonial Bank & Laundromat). The church is ahead of you.

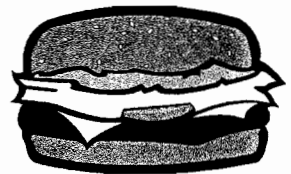

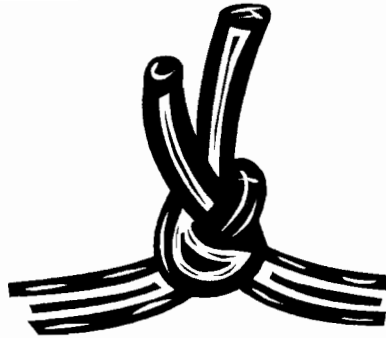
