It was brought to the RCM's attention at the last Region that \$10,500.00 was removed from the convention account in Dec. 2012. The money was returned in full a couple of months later. The short term no interest loan (my words no one else's) wasn't discovered until May of 2013. The BOT treasure at the time came up with plausible excuses on why he didn't have a report for the rest of the BOT members. The "loan" wasn't discovered until the accountant closed out the books for the conventions fiscal year. By the time the treasure came forth with a report for the rest of the BOT. The money was replaced so the balances matched and nobody thought anything of it. When the "loan" was discovered the treasure was removed from serving on the BOT. Policy Motions were passed at the regional level to help prevent this from happening again.

Conference Agenda Report or CAR

Our RD (regional delegate) and RDA (alternate) have been attending World Board participated CAR workshops on the East coast. They attended MRLE in Maine and the NEZF in Buffalo NY. Val (RCMA) and myself attended MARLCNA Mid Atlantic Region Learning Conference over the weekend. That also had WB participation from 4 WB members the chair of the world board Ron, Tonna, Bob, and Mook. From talking and listening to members with a lot more experience than I have at MARLCNA and the reports from other workshops. This doesn't seem to be the best work done on the CAR. This CAR ties in the Conference Approval Track or CAT and the documents both done by the World Board seem to contradict one another in some areas. The World Board also summarized and grouped together similar regional proposals as you will see

in the CAR. This was upsetting to some regions because of the language used in the summaries and that this particular region (ABCD) worked very hard and was in contact with the World Board during the drafting of their proposal. They did so, so their proposal met all the criteria to be submitted in the CAR. They were never notified that their proposal would be summarized and wording changed. Their original proposal can be seen in the addendum section of the CAR along with all other original proposals. These seemed to be the 2 biggest issues coming out of MARLCNA, along with a couple of others. That we will talk about at the workshop.

I would also like to thank Tom our website chair for getting the CAR itself, the ballot for voting on the CAR, and the information about our CAR workshop on the website so fast. Making accessibility to these documents easily attainable for South Jersey Area members of NA. I will also be asking Tom to add the CAT to the website so if you have interest in looking at that it will be there too.

I was mistaken when I said votes for CAR needed to be in by the March Area. There is a special Regional meeting in April during the CAR years. This means all votes from home groups are due at the April Area. Again ALL VOTES DUE at APRIL AREA. A ballot was supplied by our RD and RDA that is to be used for collecting home groups votes.
